### What is the Christian Standard Bible?

The Christian Standard Bible (CSB) is a highly trustworthy, faithful translation that is proven to be the optimal blend of accuracy and readability. The Christian Standard Bible is a revision of the HCSB, updating translation and word choices in order to optimize both fidelity to the original languages and clarity for a modern audience. The Translation Oversight Committee, co-chaired by Drs. Tom Schreiner and David Allen, incorporated advances in biblical scholarship and input from Bible scholars, pastors, and readers further hone both accuracy and readability.

# What denominations were involved in creating the CSB?

One hundred scholars from 17 denominations translated the HCSB from the original Hebrew, Greek, and Aramaic manuscripts. Keeping that trans-denominational focus, the revision and oversight committee of the CSB is comprised of top biblical scholars from a variety of conservative, evangelical denominations, including Southern Baptist, Lutheran, Presbyterian, conservative Anglican and non-denominational Bible churches.

# **How does the Christian Standard Bible compare to other translations?**

The CSB lands in the sweet spot between the more formal ("word-for-word") translations and more dynamic ("thought-for-thought") translations. An analysis by the Global Bible Initiative has proven that the Christian Standard Bible is the optimal combination of fidelity to the original languages and readability for a modern audience. The CSB was created using Optimal Equivalence, a translation philosophy that balances contemporary English readability with linguistic precision of the original languages, making it ideal not only for preaching and study, but for sharing with others.

### Why should I choose the Christian Standard Bible over other Bible translations?

- The CSB is an original translation: more than 100 scholars from 17 denominations translated directly from the best available Hebrew, Greek and Aramaic source texts into English. Its Greek source text is *the* standard used by scholars and seminaries today.

Holman Bible Publishers, a division of LifeWay, is the non-profit ministry that holds the copyright of the CSB and is responsible for its stewardship and its commercial publishing.

# Why was the word "Holman" removed from the name of the translation?

Holman Bible Publishers has a proud heritage as the oldest North American Bible publisher, dating back to 1743. While the publishing entity retains that name, the Holman name in the name of a Bible translation often created more questions than answers (who was Mr. Holman?). "Christian Standard Bible" removes those questions and increases appeal to the broad audience that the CSB is designed to serve.
